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1. Acceptable use of the Internet

Through the act of hiring a room or any facility at Salford Hall and requesting access to the Salford Community Association (SCA) wi-fi hub you have agreed to abide by these terms and conditions. We will seek actively to prosecute where the SCA has or is being held accountable for illegal use of our facilities.

2. Passwords

If internet access has been requested and the appropriate fee paid you will be given a password to access the user wi-fi hub, located on the ground floor at Salford Hall.

Maintenance of the secrecy of the password is the responsibility of the hirer and should use of the internet violate UK or international law or the SCA be investigated for illegal internet use we will expect the hirer to provide a list of people to whom they have allowed access.

Passwords will expire monthly. If you are a regular user of our facilities we will arrange for you to have a series of passwords in advance for each month but never more than 6 months in advance.

3. Use of the internet

Use of the Internet should be in accordance with the following guidelines:

- Transmission of any material in violation of any United Kingdom or other national or international laws is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to, copyrighted material, threatening or obscene material or material protected by trade laws
- Only access suitable material – Using the Internet to obtain, download, send, print, display or otherwise transmit or gain access to materials which are unlawful, obscene or abusive is not permitted.
- Respect the work and ownership rights of people, including abiding by copyright laws.
- Do not access sites that you believe may represent a significant security threat to the SCA network. Such sites may include peer to peer networks.

- Do not attempt to download or install software from our hub. If you wish to upgrade your software or installation please do this from your personal hub.
- You are reminded that ALL Internet access is logged and actively monitored and traceable by our service provider, even if you are using an incognito browser function.
