## **Family Treasure Hunt**

The Treasure Hunt starts and ends at the Little Cafe, Manor Road, and you can do it at any time during the Festival Week.

**ROUTE:** This is a circular route and includes:

- a sort stretch along the main road
- some steps
- narrow footpaths
- two quite steep footpaths
- some short stretches of road with no pavement

You should allow about 2 hours to find all the clues, but you don't have to do it all at once!

Not all the clues will be on the same side of the road, so please take care if you need to cross over, and be mindful of the traffic at all times.

**Please do not enter private property.**

The prizes will be awarded to the team, and runners up, with the highest number of correct answers. In the event of a tie, those entries with the highest number of correct answers will be entered into a draw to decide the winner. The organiser's decision is final!
